

We have D1 and D3 college athletes, current Law School students, Fraternity/Sorority Presidents, and Hillel board members.

Let's make one thing clear first; they don't work 24/7 for 8 weeks on end, work all day in the heat, and live in non-air conditioned cabins for the pay. These staff genuinely LOVE working with kids. 
