Torah Portion: B'haalot'cha Numbers 8:1-12:16

Friday Night

- Masada
 - Masada led the first Friday Night Shabbat Service. Each camper lead at least one song or prayer. They created a haiku and wrote songs about Masada and their last Shabbat at camp. Campers also told stories about their memories at camp. The entire unit wrote a song to close the service.

Saturday Morning

- Younger Habonim
 - On Saturday morning, Younger Hab led services. Each cabin had the opportunity to lead one or two songs or prayers. In addition, each cabin wrote and performed a creative expression. The creative expressions were about camp, Shabbat, the Torah portion or bringing a new song to camp. The main theme of this week's Torah portion had to do with adapting to change and fitting religion into one's lifestyle.

AREA: Pool
